

A COVENANT BETWEEN MINISTERS IN THE LATROBE & SOUTH BANYULE NETWORK

The ministers of the LaTrobe and South Banyule Network, believing that the ministry of Jesus Christ and the mission of the Triune God in this region will best be served by their entering into a co-operative relationship through the Network, willingly enter into this covenant.

The Ministers Covenant together

- ✚ To enter into a relationship in which they will exercise their individual ministries within a collegiate relationship.
- ✚ To work together in all matters of ministry (including placements); and in worship; outreach; mission; pastoral care; strategy; property and resources
- ✚ To commit themselves to the shared purpose of maintaining their covenanted relationship to fulfill the mission of the Network *viz.* Growing the Christian community and ministry within the La Trobe and South Banyule Region.
- ✚ To meet regularly as a team for prayer, sharing and planning.
- ✚ To make this commitment with the acknowledgment their own foundational values and beliefs will be respected within the Collegiate Ministry Team.
- ✚ Recognizing that under UCA Regulations the Presbytery is the Council responsible for the discipline and oversight of ministers and congregations. Therefore in the first instance, they are responsible to the Presbytery for the exercise of their ministry. Within the Network they have a secondary accountability to their colleagues within the Ministry Team.
- ✚ Recognizing that some aspects of how their Collegiality will be expressed will only become clear as the Network grows and their relationships develop.




