Come away for a weekend of fun nestled in the bush just near Melbourne. There'll be random acts of thanksgiving, we'll look for God's gifts and we'll explore the idea of living a life of gratitude.

Our theme is *Beauty from Brokenness*. No one is immune to trials—cancer, death, divorce, loss of jobs—the list goes on. How does one cope with these traumatic events? How does God take brokenness and make something good from it? Let's explore this together.

What we'll do

There'll be lots of activities for children and adults over the weekend. We'll start on the Friday evening, with an optional movie.

On Saturday, we'll have a range of activities in the morning. After lunch, you can choose from the flying fox, archery or simply a quiet walk. In the evening, we aim to have an impromptu concert before games and a camp fire. Following breakfast on Sunday morning, we'll have a worship service before lunch, after which we'll head home. There will be plenty of time for quiet activities such as jigsaws and of course getting to know each other.

Oasis Camp

The camp is a short drive from Melbourne and is nestled in the bush at Mt Evelyn. The camp has excellent facilities with great meals in a lovely big dining/activity area, a large gymnasium for kids to play in as well as interesting activities for the whole family including environmental trails, a low ropes course, archery, a flying fox, reptile house, table tennis pool tables and a camp fire.
